

# Keep Kids Safe!

Approximately one-third of families with children keep at least one gun in the home.



In 2005, there were 33 unintentional firearm deaths of children and teens in Pennsylvania.

Nearly all childhood unintentional shooting deaths occur in or near the home.



**Gun locks** properly installed on your firearms could greatly reduce unintentional firearm deaths.

# Gun Safety Tips

1. Keep guns unloaded and locked.
2. Store guns and ammunition separately.
3. Be sure guns are out of reach of children.
4. Always ask other parents if there are guns where your child will be playing.

Teach your child these tips if they see a gun:

- Don't touch it.
- Leave the area.
- Tell an adult.
