Senate Bill 200 (Sen. Browne) - An Act establishing standards for managing concussions and traumatic brain injuries to student athletes; assigning duties to the Department of Health and the Department of Education; and imposing penalties.

House Bill 1362 (Rep. Neuman) - An Act requiring administration of a baseline test and removal from athletic activity of an athlete who shows symptoms of a concussion.

Senate Bill 920 (Sen. Browne) - An Act providing standards for carbon monoxide alarms; and imposing penalties.

Teen Driver/Wireless Communication

House Bill 9 (Rep. Watson) - An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for junior driver's license, for learners' permits, for suspension of operating privilege, for department to compile, tabulate and analyze accident reports and for restraint systems.

Referred to Transportation, Feb. 24, 2011

Reported as amended, May 3, 2011

Senate Bill 635 (Sen. Wozniak) - An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, defining "interactive wireless communications device"; further providing for junior driver's license and for suspension of operating privilege; prohibiting interactive wireless communications devices; and further providing for duty of driver in construction and maintenance areas or on highway safety corridors, for duty of driver in emergency response areas, for accident report forms, for department to compile, tabulate and analyze accident reports, for television equipment and for restraint systems.

Referred to Transportation, Feb. 24, 2011

Senate Bill 314 (Sen. Tomlinson) - An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, defining "interactive wireless communications device"; providing for prohibiting use of interactive wireless communications devices while operating motor vehicles; and further providing for duty of driver in construction and maintenance areas or on highway safety corridors, for duty of driver in emergency response areas, for accident report forms, for department to compile, tabulate and analyze accident reports, for television equipment, for applicability and uniformity of law and for disposition and use of liquid fuels and fuels tax.

Referred to Transportation, Jan. 28, 2011

House Bill 146 (Rep. Kortz) - An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in rules of the road in general, prohibiting interactive wireless communications devices and prohibiting use of interactive wireless communications devices by junior drivers; further providing for duty of driver in construction and maintenance areas or on highway safety corridors, for duty of driver in emergency response areas and for the offense of careless driving; establishing the Driver Distraction Awareness Fund; and providing for additional duties of the Department of Transportation.

Senate Bill 749 (Sen. Dinniman) - An Act amending Titles 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) and 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for Commonwealth portion of fines, etc. and for municipal corporation portion of fines, etc.; defining "interactive wireless communication device"; further providing for junior driver's license, for learners' permits and for suspension of operating privilege; prohibiting use of interactive wireless communication device; and further providing for duty of driver in construction and maintenance areas or on highway safety corridors, for duty of driver in emergency response areas, for accident report forms, for department to compile, tabulate and analyze accident reports, for television equipment, for restraint systems and for applicability and uniformity of title.

House Bill 330 (Rep. Shapiro) - An Act amending Titles 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) and 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for Commonwealth portion of fines, etc. and for municipal corporation portion of fines, etc.; defining "interactive wireless communication device"; further providing for junior driver's license, for learners' permits and for suspension of operating privilege; prohibiting use of interactive wireless communication device; and further providing for duty of driver in construction and maintenance areas or on highway safety corridors, for duty of driver in emergency response areas, for accident report forms, for department to compile, tabulate and analyze accident reports, for television equipment, for restraint systems and for applicability and uniformity of title.
